PHOTOMICROGRAPHY OF ZEBRAFISH, XENOPUS, AND OTHER AQUATIC SPECIES

- 1. DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION is September 30, 2016. Files may be submitted by email...
2. All photomicrography images submitted must be created by the entrant depicting studies with zebrafish, Xenopus frogs, or other aquatic species...
3. The following guidelines for file format MUST be followed: Files must be jpeg only, 300ppi, sized to 8x10" or 8x8"...
4. Description of image(s) must be included on entry form including the disease or condition being studied...
5. Contest is open to researchers, students (undergrad or graduate) and post docs. No employees of imaging equipment manufacturers or dealers are eligible...
6. Judging will be done by an outside panel of photography, science, and art professionals. Decision of the judges is final. Award recipients will be notified by December 2016.
7. PRIZES: • First Prize – \$1,000 • Second Prize - \$750 • Third Prize - \$500
